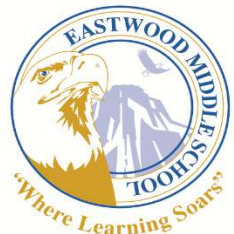

Steps to Completing Your Course Requests

1. Login to your Skyward Account
2. On the left hand side select the “**Schedule**” tab
At the top of the page on the right side it should say “Course Request: Now Open”
3. Select the hyperlink “View Requests for 2017-2018”
Along the left hand side you will see a list of course options.
4. Highlight the courses on the left, select “Add Course” and this will move the course to your Course Request Sheet

The credits need to add up to the number of openings you have (4 Elective Credits).

5. Select the hyperlink “**Requests Alternates**” at the top of the page.
Select Alternative Courses and add them to your Request Alternates List in the event that you are unable to get your primary requests.

Review Your Choices

If you are pleased with your selections, select PRINT.

Please print two (2) copies and take them back to your seat.

Remember: Take one home to review with your parents. You may make changes at home in SKYWARD before the date on your Schedule.

One copy will be picked up as you exit the room.
